TNAX jagħzel 12-il ritratt, meħudin minn fotografi differenti u li ġejjin minn diversi oqsma, li juru l-livelli multikulturali tal-Belt Valletta minn ghajnejn fotografi Maltin u barranin, waqt il-mixjet u l-osservazzjonijiet tagħhom fil-Belt Valletta. Il-proġett huwa mibni fuq l-essenza ta' belt mogħnija fl-istorja, li għandha t-titlu ta' Sit ta' wirt storiku dinji mill-UNESCO u kienet Kapitali Ewropea tal-Kultura fl-2018. Il-kuratrici ta' din l-esibizzjoni hija l-fotografu Therese Debono.

TNAX will source 12 images, shot by various photographers having diverse backgrounds, that show the multicultural layers of the city of Valletta through the eyes of local and foreign photographers, during their walks and observations in the capital. The project captures the essence of a capital rich in history, that is a UNESCO World Heritage site and was European Capital of Cultural in 2018. This exhibition is curated by photographer Therese Debono.

Ir-residenti tal-Belt Valletta se jkunu mistiedna jospitaw lis-surmast u pjanist Brian Schembri f'darhom waqt li dan jippreżenta wieħed mill-aktar kapulavuri importanti ta' Beethoven, is-Sonata *Hammerklavier*. Dawn il-prestazzjonijiet, li se jiċċelebraw il-memorja ta' Beethoven, se jsiru fi djar residenzjali, biex il-kumpanija u l-mužika tiegħi jitgawdew, jiġu ammirati u jinhassu minn dawk ta' madwaru waqt serata d-dar mal-ħbieb u l-familja.

Valletta residents will host conductor and pianist Brian Schembri in their own home as he presents one of Beethoven's most important masterpieces, the *Hammerklavier* sonata. These performances will take place in residential houses, celebrating Beethoven's memory; his company and music being enjoyed, admired and felt by those around him, during an evening at home with friends and family.


Il-kelma ġermaniża 'lied' ilha tintuża sa mis-Seklu 12 AD biex tirreferi għal polifonija li tgħaqqaqad il-poezija mal-mużika. Bi-Ingliz jirreferu għaliha bħala 'art song', ġeneru li kiber matul il-perijodu Romantiku, simili għall-alkemija, meta l-komponenti jingħaqdu flimkien joħrog hoss magiku.

Għal din is-serata, il-vuċi dehbiena ta' Tatiana Lisnic se tingħaqqaqad man-noti melodiċi tal-arpa, f'idejn Britt Arend, għal rappreżentazzjoni ta' 'lieder' bil-Franċiż, Ĝermaniż u r-Russu. Fost il-lieder li se jindaqu mill-arpista hemm dawk ta' Faure, Lizst, Strauss u Rachmaninoff.

From as early as the 12th century AD, the German word 'lied' is used to refer to a polyphony which brings together poetry and classical music. English speakers refer to it as 'art song', a genre which flourished in the Romantic era.

On this late night, the golden voice of Tatiana Lisnic joins the melodic notes of harpist Britt Arend to perform lieder in French, German and Russian by Faure, Lizst, Strauss and Rachmaninoff amongst others.



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InnovAiR

Il-Programm InnovAiR inħoloq sabiex jarrikkixxi u jikkontribwixxi għall-kuntest kreattiv nazzjonali. Ir-residenzi għall-artisti jrawmu l-kollaborazzjoni u l-komunikazzjoni bejn l-artisti u l-komunitajiet lokali ta' artisti, residenti u ħaddiema, filwaqt li jheġġu l-iskambju u l-użu ġdid ta' spazji u ambjenti differenti. L-ewwel residenzi fi Frar se jistiednu artisti, kollettivi u persuni kreattivi biex jesploraw mid-dar jew mill-istudjow tagħhom il-kunċett “Irrisetja”. Qed inheġġu lill-artisti biex jesploraw suġġetti bħal-libertà tal-moviment, il-benesseri, is-sostenibbiltà, il-fiduċja soċċjali, it-territorju u l-ispażjalitā fid-dinja ta' wara l-pandemija.

InnovAiR aims to contribute to and enrich the national creative context. Artist residencies foster collaboration and networking between artists and the local community of artists, residents and workers whilst encouraging sharing and the re-invention of digital and physical spaces. The first residences in February will invite artists, collectives and creatives to explore from their home or studio the concept of “Reset”. Artists are encouraged to explore topics such as freedom of movement, well-being, sustainability, social trust, territory and spatiality in a post-pandemic world.





L-Opra Written on Skin ittellgħat ghall-ewwel darba waqt il-Festival d'Aix-en-Provence fl-2012 u hija xogħol tal-kompożitor Ingliz George Benjamin. Ser tigi eżegwita mill-Malta Philharmonic Orchestra flimkien ma' 5 solisti internazzjonali, taħt id-direzzjoni ta' Lawrence Renes. Miktub minn Martin Crimp, il-librett huwa bbażat fuq il-leġġenda tat-trovatur Guillaume de Cabestanh u teħodna lejn Provenza fis-seklu tlettak. The Guardian ikklasifikat din l-opra bhala bhala wahda mill-aqwa xogħilijiet ta' mužika klassika miktuba f'dan is-seklu.



Premiered at the 2012 Festival d'Aix-en-Provence, Written on Skin is an opera by British composer George Benjamin. It will be performed in Malta by the Malta Philharmonic Orchestra and five renowned soloists, directed by Lawrence Renes. Penned by Martin Crimp, the libretto is based on the legend of the troubadour Guillaume de Cabestanh with a story taking place in 13th Century Provence. The work ranks as one of the best pieces of contemporary classical music by The Guardian.

Dan huwa xogħol teatrali makabru li fih il-biżgħat tat-tfulija jithalltu mal-wieġġhat tal-adultezza; fejn is-sagru jinbidel f'inkubu, u l-ġrieħi mill-kustat minnflok demm li jifdi jnixxu demm li jkexxex. Vari huwa dramm ibbazat fuq in-novella Vari ta' Trevor Zahra li dehret għall-ewwel darba fil-ġabru ta' novelli Lubien fl-1995.

This is a macabre theatrical work in which childhood fears mix with adult hardships; where the sacred transforms into a nightmare, and where the blood which oozes from the ribs is shuddering, rather than redemptive. *Vari* is a play based on Trevor Zahra's novel *Vari* which was first published in the collection Lubien in 1995.

Din ir-rappreżentazzjoni hija ispirata mis-seba' visti li jsiru fil-knejjes minn bosta devoti f'Hamis ix-Xirkxa.

Tikkonsisti f'seba' prestazzjonijiet korali qosra f'seba' knejjes differenti ġewwa l-Belt Valletta. Kull prestazzjoni tistieden lill-udjenza biex taħseb fil-fond dwar waħda minn dawk magħrufa bħala "the Seven Last Words of Christ" (l-aħħar seba' kelmiet ta' Kristu) - serje ta' frażijiet li jingħad li ntqalu minn Kristu fl-aħħar mumenti tiegħu fuq is-salib - permezz ta' kombinazzjoni ta' kant liturġiku, mužika korali u qari ta' riflessjoni miktub minn membri tal-komunità Beltija flimkien ma seba' awturi lokali.

Ejja u imxi f'pellegrinaġġ flimkien mal-kor, jew attendi għall-prestazzjoni li tixtieq fi knisja tal-ġhażla tiegħek.

This roaming performance is inspired by the 'visit to the seven churches' synonymous with Maundy Thursday.

It consists of seven short choral meditations, held across seven churches in Valletta. Each one invites the audience to ponder on one of the "Seven Last Words of Christ" - a series of sayings attributed to Christ's final moments on the cross - by combining plainchant, choral music and reflective readings, written by members of the Valletta community working alongside seven local authors.

You may follow the choir on its 'pilgrimage' or attend specific performances in the respective churches.



Progett ta' legat tal-Kapitali Ewropea tal-Kultura 2018, il-Valletta Design Cluster (VDC), li jinsab gewwa l-binja rinnovata tal-Biċċerija l-Antika, huwa spazju għall-komunità maħluq għal użu prattiku kulturali u kreattiv. Il-kontributuri principali ta' dan l-isforz kbir ta' riġenerazzjoni huma r-residenti u l-komunitajiet ġirien, flimkien mal-prattikanti kreattivi u s-socjetà civili. Is-servizzi generali u l-facilitajiet ser ikunu miftuħa għall-istudenti, għaqdiet non-governattivi, prattikanti kreattivi, u kumpanji start-ups, kif ukoll organizzazzjonijiet attivi fl-oqsma soċjali u kreattivi. L-istudjows tagħna jipprovdha post tax-xogħol stabbli għall-organizzazzjonijiet fis-settu kulturali u kreattivi, filwaqt li l-VDC ser ikollu wkoll ġnien fuq il-bejt li ser iservi bħala spazju pubbliku qđid fil-Belt Valletta.

A legacy project of the 2018 European Capital of Culture in Valletta, the Valletta Design Cluster (VDC) is a community space for cultural and creative practice situated in the renovated Old Abattoir (Il-Biċċerija l-Antika) in Valletta. The key human contributors to this major regeneration effort are Valletta residents and neighbouring communities, together with cultural and creative practitioners and civil society changemakers. Our general services and facilities are open to students, NGOs, residents, creative practitioners and start-ups, as well as organisations active in the social and cultural sector. Our studios provide a more stable workspace for organisations working in the cultural and creative sector, while the building shall also be adorned with a green roof which will serve as a new public garden in Valletta.

European Open Design School for Sustainable Regional Development

L-Aġenċija Kulturali għall-Belt Valletta, permezz tal-Valletta Design Cluster, hija membru uffiċjali ta' DeuS, progett ta' tħarriġ volkazzjonali u edukattiv tal-Erasmus+ li jiffoka fuq il-potenzjal tas-settar kulturali u kreattiv. Dan il-progett ta' sentejn (2020-2021) jgħaqqa flimkien għaxart isħab minn disa' pajjiżi Ewropej, inkluži erba' Kapitali Ewropej tal-Kultura. Matull l-ewwel parti tal-2021, ser inkomplu naħdmu ma' shabna lokali u Ewropej li huma attivi fit-tħarriġ u l-edukazzjoni. L-għan tagħna huwa li ninvestigaw għażiex ta' tħarriġ alternattiv u informali li jifformaw parti integrali mill-proċess ko-kreattiv fis-settur kulturali, u li nsibu approċċ komuni Ewropew li jirrikonoxxi u jagħti valur lil dawn il-ħiliet, għall-benefiċċju tal-prattikanti fis-settur.

The Valletta Cultural Agency, through the Valletta Design Cluster, is an official member of DeuS, an Erasmus+ vocational educational training project that focuses on unlocking the potential of the cultural and creative sector. This two-year project (2020-2021) brings together ten partners from nine EU countries, including four European Capitals of Culture. During the first part of 2021, we will continue working with local and European partners active in training and education. Our focus here is to investigate alternative, informal training paths that form an integral part of co-creative processes in the cultural sector, and to find a common European approach to recognize and valorize these skills, for the benefit of practitioners in this sector.



Matul l-2021, il-Valletta Design Cluster, ser ikun qed itella' programm ta' attivitajiet u workshops b'rabta mal-inizjattiva Wikimedian-in-Residence. Dan il-proġett qed jittella' b'kollaborazzjoni mal-Komunità Maltija tal-Wikimedia. Matul l-ewwel kwart tal-2021, din il-kollaborazzjoni ser tiffoka fuq żewġ inizjattivi: l-inizjattiva Wiki Loves Art u l-inizjattiva Wiki Takes the Valletta Design Cluster, li hija marbuta direttament mal-ftuh tal-Valletta Design Cluster. Serje ta' workshops u attivitajiet ser jittellgħu fil-VDC u onlajn u dawn ser jipprovd lill-parteċipanti b'għarfien u ħiliet marbuta mal-valuri komuni kemm għall-VDC kif ukoll għall-Komunità Maltija tal-Wikimedia: l-acċess miftuħ, il-qsim tal-għarfien u l-ko-kreazzjoni.

Wikimedian-in-Residence Programme

Throughout 2021, the Valletta Design Cluster will be hosting a programme of activities and workshops linked to its Wikimedian-in-Residence initiative. This is carried out in collaboration with Wikimedia Community Malta. During the first quarter of 2021, this collaboration will focus on two initiatives: the Wiki Loves Art initiative and the Wiki Takes the Valletta Design Cluster initiative that is directly linked to the opening of the Valletta Design Cluster. A series of workshops and events will be held at the Cluster and online, and these will provide participants with insights and skills linked to the Cluster's shared values: open access, knowledge sharing, and co-creation.





Open Week and Official Opening of the Valletta Design Cluster

Il-ftuħ ufficjali tal-Valletta Design Cluster ser isir lejn l-aħħar ta' Marzu, bi programm ta' aktivitajiet u żjarat bil-għan li l-pubbliku inġenerali jsir familjari mal-faċilitajiet il-ġodda. Wara snin ta' restawr u xogħlijiet, il-bini ser jinfetaħ għall-prattikanti kreattivi u kulturali, studenti, residenti, u l-pubbliku ġeneral. Il-faċilitajiet il-ġodda ser jinkludu spazji għall-ko-hidma, kmamar għal-laqgħat, "makerspace, spazju tal-ikel li jinkludi kċina għat-ġaqbz, u ġnien fuq il-bejt aċċessibbli għall-pubbliku. Matul il-ġimħa tal-ftuħ, ser isiru serje ta' żjarat bieq jiġu spjegati l-faċilitajiet u l-mod kif jistgħu jintużaw mill-membri tal-pubbliku. Filgħaxxijiet ser isiru serje ta' fora pubbliċi dwar kwistionijiet fil-qalba tal-proġett. Dawn jittrattaw: (a) liema prinċipji għandhom jiggwidaw il-konverżjoni ta'si urbani b'valur ta' wirt għal užu kontemporjanu; u (b) kif nistgħu nużaw il-kollaborazzjoni biex niġġeneraw il-valur soċċali, kulturali u ekonomiku. Il-programm tal-ftuħ ser jittella' matul ġimħa shiħa, bil-ftuħ ufficjali jseħħi is-Sibt 27 ta' Marzu filgħaxija.

The official opening week of the Valletta Design Cluster will be held towards the end of March, with a programme of activities and tours aimed at familiarizing the general public with this new facility. After years of painstaking restoration and conversion, the building will be opening its doors for cultural and creative practitioners, students, makers, residents, and the general public. The new facilities will include co-working spaces, meeting rooms, a makerspace, a foodspace inclusive of a teaching kitchen, a number of studios and a publicly accessible roof garden. During the open week, a series of tours will be organized to explain the facilities and the ways in which members of the public will be able to benefit from this project. During the evenings, a series of public fora will be held to tackle issues at the core of this project. These include the following main themes: (a) which principles should guide the conversion of urban sites of heritage value for contemporary use; and (b) how we can use collaboration and sharing as an approach to generate social, cultural and economic value. While the opening programme will run throughout the full week, the official opening ceremony will be taking place on Saturday 27th March in the evening.

The Strada Stretta Concept

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Għall-Programm tas-sena 2021, The Strada Stretta Concept, taħt id-direzzjoni artistika tal-Professur Giuseppe Schembri Bonaci, jissokta b'serie ta' progetti innovattivi ispirati mill-enerġija u l-istorja Boemjana li tikkaratterizza din it-trid. L-ewwel appuntament fuq il-kalendaru huwa l-Kwartett ta' Sammy Murgo bi prestazzjoni ta' mužika jazz live, li jkompli jarrikkixxi l-hajja partikolari ta' din it-trid. Aktar tard, grupp teatrali Franciż ser jinterpreta l-opra ta' Darius Milhaud, "Le Pauvre Matelot", li tidħol tant tajjeb mal-kuntest kulturali ta' Strada Stretta. F'Ġunju mbagħad, ser tittella' prestazzjoni artistika minn artisti Inglizi tul it-toroq kollha tal-Belt li tispicċa f'The Gut. Din ser toħloq spettaklu partikolari sajf li mhux ta' min jitilfu. L-ahħar avveniment fuq il-kalendaru tagħna huwa verżjoni Ģermaniża tax-xogħol ta' Brecht, The "Threepenny Opera", li se jittella' bil-Malti u li huwa bbażat fi Strada Stretta.

For the 2021 programme, The Strada Stretta Concept, under the artistic direction of Professor Giuseppe Schembri Bonaci, continues to feature a series of innovative projects which draw inspiration from the Bohemian energy and history that palpitates throughout the street. The calendar begins with The Sammy Murgo Quartet performing live jazz, enlivening as always the character of the street. The next project features a French theatre troupe performing the Darius Milhaud's opera "Le Pauvre Matelot". This would beautifully fit in the cultural context of Strada Stretta. Later in June there will be an art performance, by British artists, all through Valletta's streets which will end up in The Gut. The calendar ends with a distinctly Strada Stretta German version of Brecht's "The Threepenny Opera", in Maltese.


